- g. Seating capacity of 50 or less
- h. Satisfactory CORI results
- i. Beer and wine only

A.

Restaurants, with less than fifty (50) seats, providing tables and tips certified wait staff service, may apply for a license which allows consumption of wine and malt beverages on their premises.

B.

The annual fee for a brown bag license is:

New: four hundred fifty dollars (\$450.00)

Renewal: four hundred dollars (\$400.00)

and is renewable on July 1st of each year.

C.

Alcoholic beverages may only be consumed between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m., by patrons seated at a table with an entrée being served by the licensee.

D.

The manager of each licensed premises shall submit to a satisfactory CORI check, and ensure the licensing commission that it has adequate liquor liability insurance.

E.

Licensees must abide by all rules and regulations set out in chapter 5.04, and allow inspection without notice to members of the police department, board of health, fire department and building inspector.

F.

Violations of any of the aforementioned rules and regulations will be adjudicated by the town licensing board and may result in suspension, loss of license and/or a one hundred dollar (\$100.00) to three hundred dollar (\$300.00) fine for each offense.
